In order to have the best possible SOC-IN, we as individuals and as a community understand and agree to the following rules and guidelines. The staff reserves the right to take disciplinary action toward any person who does not abide by this covenant, *including asking them to leave*. Please read through the following information carefully and prayerfully before signing.

1. Please have enough respect for the camp grounds and their surroundings so as not to damage them. Participants will be held financially responsible for damages they incur.
2. Participants will sign in with the Staff upon arrival and notify the Staff in charge upon departure.
3. All participants, youth and adults, will take a responsibility for themselves by dressing appropriately. It is not suitable for males or females to wear clothes that expose undergarments (bras, boxers, etc.). A participant may be asked to change clothes if an adult decides that their attire is inappropriate.
4. Show consideration and respect for others over the weekend. Offensive language is not considerate or respectful to the community.
5. Alcohol, illegal drugs, artificial stimulants (Vivarin, NoDoze, etc.) and abuse of over-the-counter drugs are detrimental to the SOC-IN atmosphere and will not be tolerated.
6. The use of tobacco products of any kind is not allowed.
7. Inappropriate displays of affection or sexual activity will not be permitted.
8. The purpose of the weekend is to raise the Happening participants and staff up in prayer and to grow closer to God through Jesus Christ. As a community focused on Christ, and understanding the many different faces of our Church, we covenant to refrain from discussing potentially divisive topics or the politics of the church.
